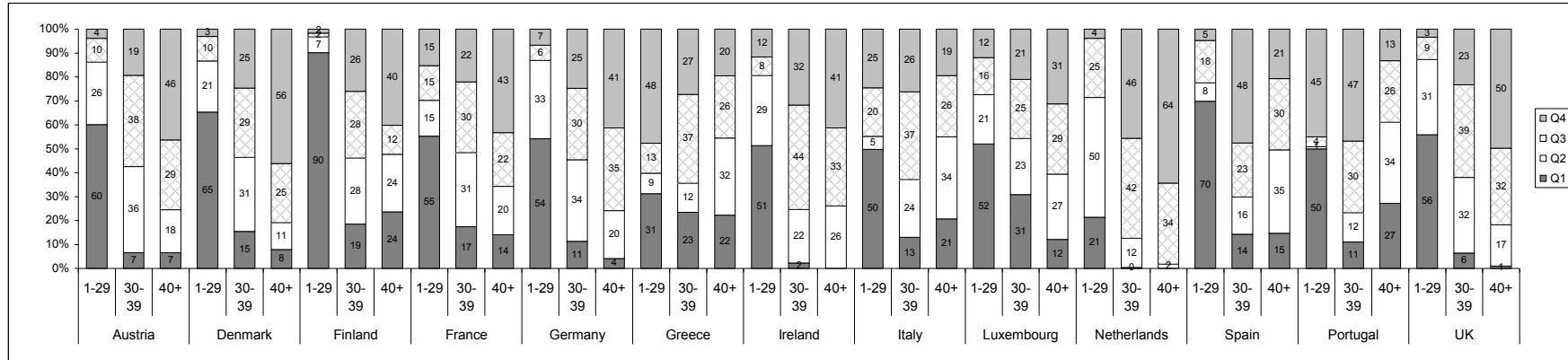

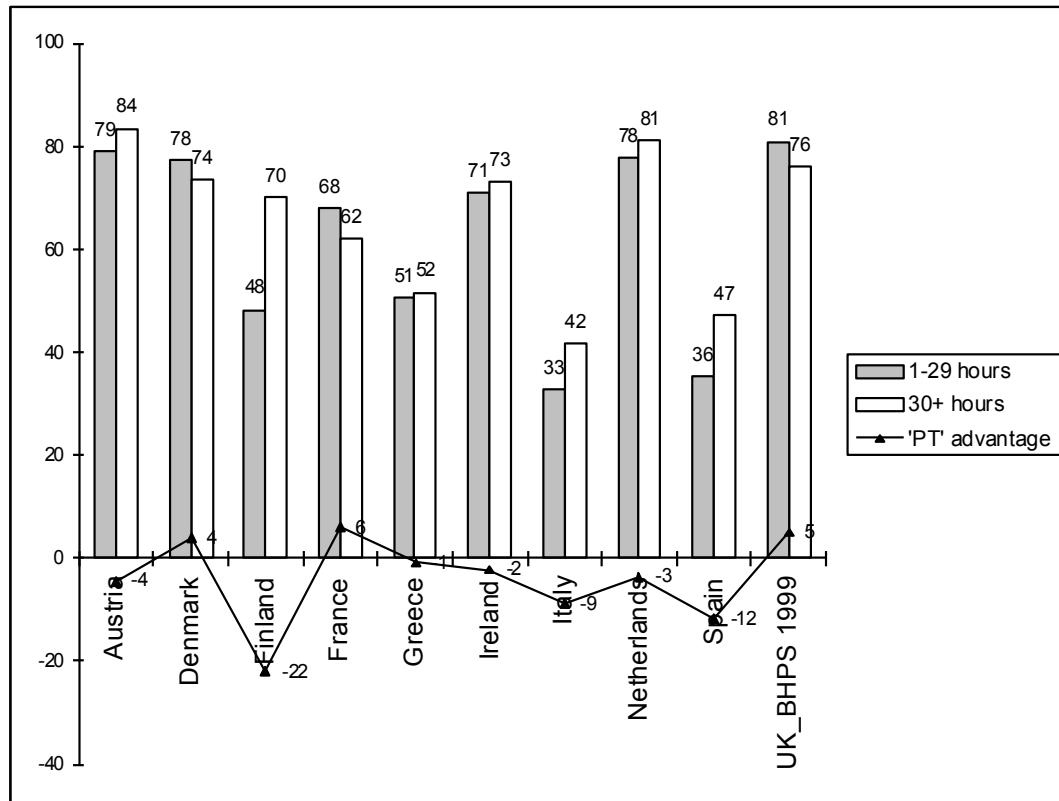

Figure 1. Distribution of female employees (aged 25-55) through wage quartiles (net monthly) by hours groups.



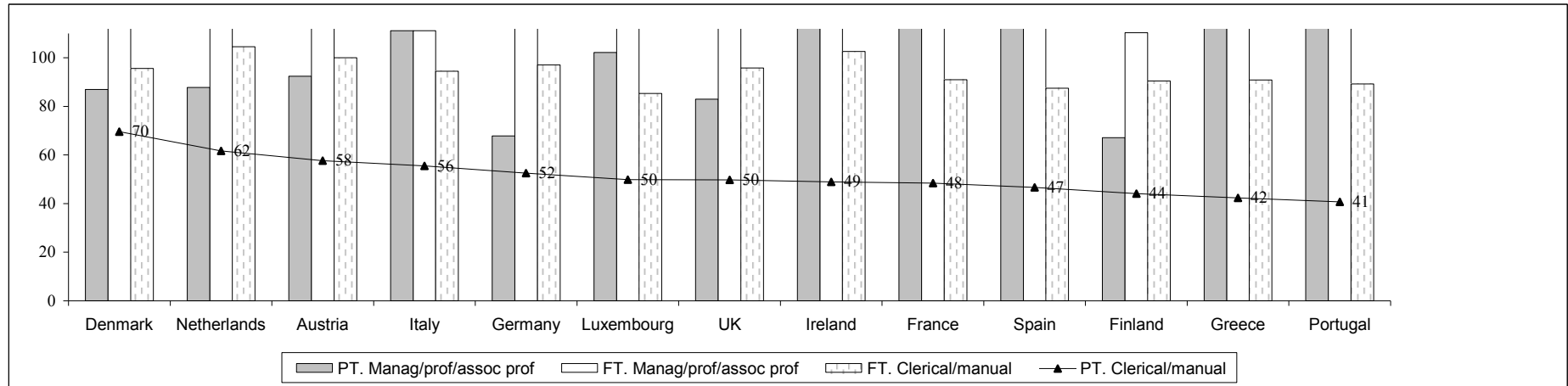
