# Ethnicity and suicide risk: a population-based study from England

# Abstract (96)

Using multiple linked electronic health databases, we conducted a large case-control study in England from 2001 through 2019 to examine the association between ethnicity and suicide risk. Asian, Black and Other ethnic groups had a significantly lower suicide risk compared to White individuals, with those of Asian ethnicity having the lowest risk (Odds Ratio 0.53, 95% Confidence Interval 0.47-0.60). This ethnicity related suicide risk was significantly altered by socio-demographic characteristics. These factors can inform the assessment and stratification of suicide risk, as well as the targeting of public health measures designed to reduce suicide incidence.

# Introduction (165)

Suicide is a common cause of death both globally and in England. While the causes of suicide are complex and multi-factorial, identifying risk factors for suicide can help in assessing individual patients and designing public health interventions. Ethnicity and immigrant status have been proposed as risk factors but findings have been mixed (1). For example, the indigenous people of Australia (2) and the Dutch residents in the Netherlands (3) were reported to be at higher risk of suicide death than the general population and the non-Dutch residents in Netherlands, respectively. Conversely, higher risk of suicide was observed amongst non-resident Indians around the world in comparison to the native population (4). In England, a country with ethnic diversity, data on the relationship between ethnicity and suicide death has been based on only selected groups of people (5–7) and the risk of suicide in the general population remains poorly understood. We examined differences in suicide risk amongst the main ethnic groups using a population-based dataset from England.

# Methods (383)

We conducted a case-control study using linked electronic health databases: Clinical Practice Research Datalink (CPRD) for primary care records (using GOLD and Aurum databases), Hospital Episode Statistics secondary care records and the Office for National Statistics for national mortality records. CPRD has a similar composition to the UK population with regards to age, gender and ethnicity (8) and HES refers to secondary care in England. The study covered the period from 2001 through 2019 and encompassed every suicide case recorded in ONS who were eligible for linkage with the CPRD and HES databases. Controls were selected randomly and longitudinally from the sampling frame of the entire CPRD database linkable to the HES and ONS databases. Controls were matched to cases on suicide date (risk-set sampling) and general practice. Of cases, 14,240 had 40 matched controls each. A further 275 cases had between 9 and 39 controls. We only included patients aged 15 years or above at suicide/index date, patients with an acceptable quality of records who also had at least one year of complete records prior to the index/suicide date, and practices regarded as up to standard (for CPRD GOLD) in their completeness and continuity of records.

Ethnicity records were derived from CPRD and complemented from HES where necessary. Ethnicity codes for CPRD GOLD were based on a validated code list from Mathur et al. (2014) (9) and the list was updated to include additional relevant codes. Codes for CPRD Aurum were developed anew (see Supplementary information 1 for all codes used in this study). We examined six main ethnic groups (Supplementary information 2). As a proxy for socioeconomic status (SES), we used the Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD), a deprivation score based on the patient's home postcode with higher IMD scores representing lower SES. Missing data on ethnicity (13.6% of the sample) and IMD (0.5% of the sample) were handled using a separate category and multiple imputation, respectively. A sensitivity analysis limiting our study population to the period 2010-2019 was conducted. Conditional logistic regression was used to estimate odds ratios (ORs) and given the risk-set sampling nature of our study, ORs can be interpreted as rate ratios (10). Analysis was conducted using STATA v. 16. Approval was obtained for this study from the MHRA Independent Scientific Advisory Committee – reference number: 20\_186RA.

# Results (251)

The study included 594,674 participants: 14,515 suicide cases and 580,159 controls. 24% of suicide cases and 13.3% of controls had missing ethnicity data. Most suicide cases were of White ethnicity (70.9%). The relative suicide risk across different ethnic groups and their subpopulations are presented in Table 1.

Compared to White ethnicity, individuals with an Asian ethnicity were at lower risk of suicide (OR 0.53, 95% Confidence intervals CI 0.47 to 0.60) as to a marginally lesser degree were those classified as Black ethnicity (OR 0.60; 95%CI: 0.52 to 0.69). Those individuals with no data on ethnicity had a higher risk of suicide than those with White ethnicity (OR 2.15, 95% CI 2.06-2.24). The diminution of suicide risk among Black and Asian ethnicity was generally greater for female gender and those aged 55 years or above. Lower SES was associated with a lower risk of suicide in individuals of Asian, Black and Other ethnic categories. However, this was not the case for those in the Mixed or missing ethnic group categories. Based on the likelihood ratio test, all main effects and interactions (with age, gender, age and gender and SES) were statistically significant (P<0.05). Limiting the study period to 2010-2019 in the sensitivity analysis reduced the proportion of missing ethnicity data to 9.0% for cases and 9.9% for controls. This did not lead to a significant change in suicide risk across the different ethnic groups, other than for the missing ethnicity group compared to White counterparts (OR 0.86, 95% CI 0.79-0.94).

P-value was <0.05 for presented effects across all categories. A single P-value was obtained using a likelihood ratio test for all variables apart from socioeconomic status. Missing data on IMD were interpolated via multiple imputation- a single P-value for socioeconomic status was obtained using Wald test.

# Discussion (631):

This is the first large-scale population-based estimate of the relationship between suicide and ethnicity in England. Our analysis demonstrated that those identifying as White had a higher suicide risk than other ethnic groups, and that sociodemographic factors significantly modified the association between ethnicity and suicide. We have also shown that in lower SES, the Asian, Black and Other ethnicities were at lower risk compared to their White counterparts.

The data used in this study are of proven quality with cause of death being determined by official death registration and ethnicity data in linked CPRD-HES having been shown to be valid (9). While ethnicity and immigration status are correlated, the latter can represent a distinct identity group and the inability to distinguish between ethnicity and immigration status is a limitation in our study. Another limitation of our analysis includes the category with missing ethnicity data which carries the risk of ascertainment bias. However, given that the sensitivity analysis showed no significant change from our main analysis for the suicide risk across the known ethnic groups, ascertainment bias does not appear to be the explanation for our findings.

Suicide risk variations across ethnic groups may be partly due to ethnicity-specific religion and societal factors associated with the risk. As previously reported, populations with a predominance of Atheism and Christianity were at higher suicide risk than those with a predominance of Hinduism and Islam (11). This may explain the lower suicide risk amongst Asian individuals (of whom in England and Wales large proportions identify as Hindus or Muslims) compared to White individuals (who largely identify as Christians or Atheists) (12).

The tendency for suicide risk to converge towards that of the White ethnicity amongst younger non-White ethnic groups relative to older non-White ethnic groups may relate to differing upbringings and attitudes by age-group. The younger generation, who are more likely to be born in England, may have attitudes and experiences more similar to their White counterparts. Conversely, the older generations, perhaps more likely to be born outside of England, may retain attitudes and practices which offer potential protection from suicide or may be in effect a self-selected psychologically robust group willing to undergo migration. Furthermore, given that minority ethnicities are prone to live in close communities, the older generations may benefit from the more readily available social support. The potential positive effect of living in communities can also be deduced from the findings related to SES.

Minority ethnicities seem to be less affected by lower SES than their White counterparts. It could be that the local communities of ethnic minorities may decrease the sense of relative socioeconomic disparity.

Our results were comparable to those in the United States in that Asian and Black ethnicities had lower suicide risk compared to White individuals (13). Despite other previous studies in England being focused on selected groups, our findings were consistent with previous findings of reduced suicide risk amongst Asian individuals compared to White individuals (5–7). Previous data from higher education students in England and Wales showed lower suicide rates amongst Black students compared to White students (similar to the younger age-groups in our study), but slightly higher rates amongst Asian students (14). Our findings contrast to results shown amongst psychiatry patients in England and Wales, where suicide risk was increased in young Black males and females and young South-Asian females relative to their White counterparts (7). Differences in the study populations, study dates, and methods can likely explain the differences in results.

These data suggest that preventive strategies should be ethnicity-sensitive incorporating systematic and social factors distinct to each ethnicity. We recommend that ethnicity is considered when targeting suicide prevention strategies with a priority to White ethnicity, particularly those with a lower SES, and the more affluent and younger age-groups of ethnic minority communities.
