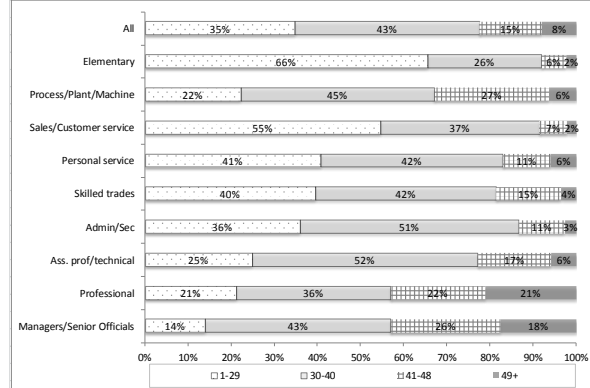
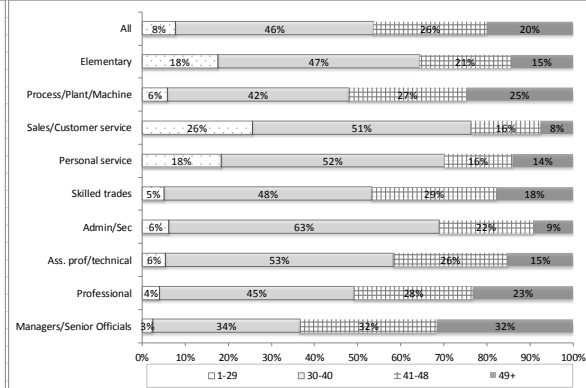


Figure 1. Hours of weekly labour market work¹. Employees aged 18–64. 2012-13.

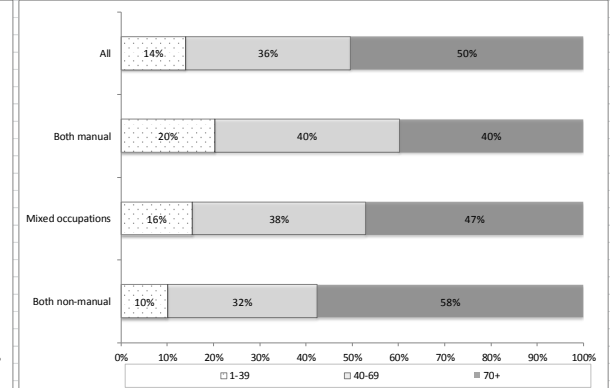
a. Women

c. Dual employed couples' combined hours²



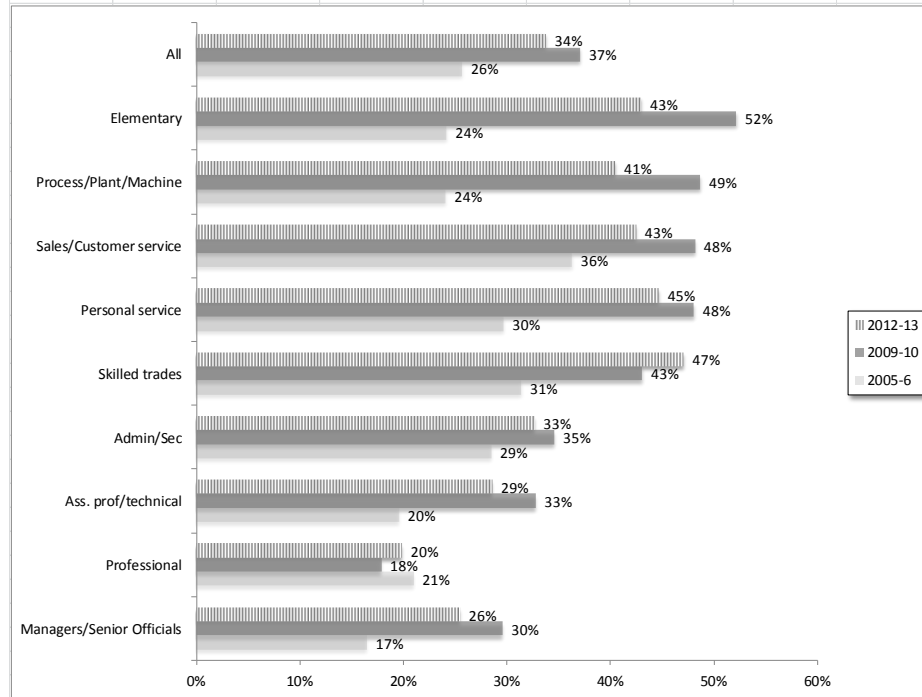

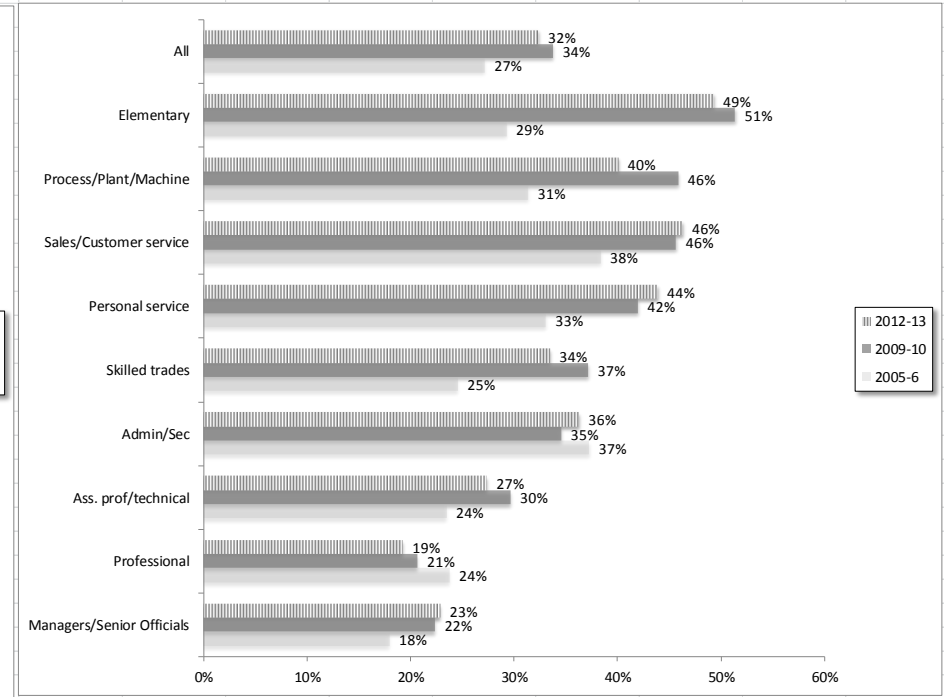

a. Women



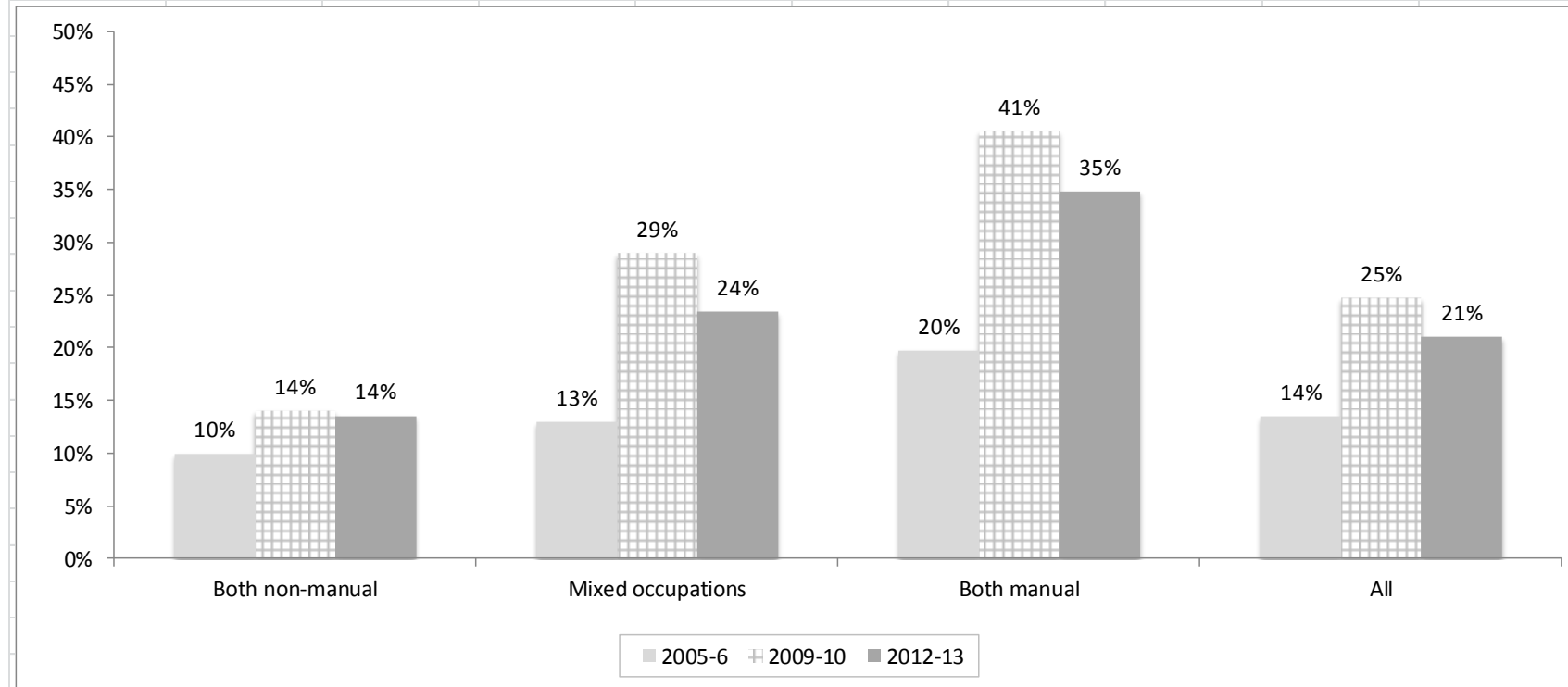

Figure 3. Proportion of dual-employed working¹ age mixed-sex couples who both report being in financial difficulties².

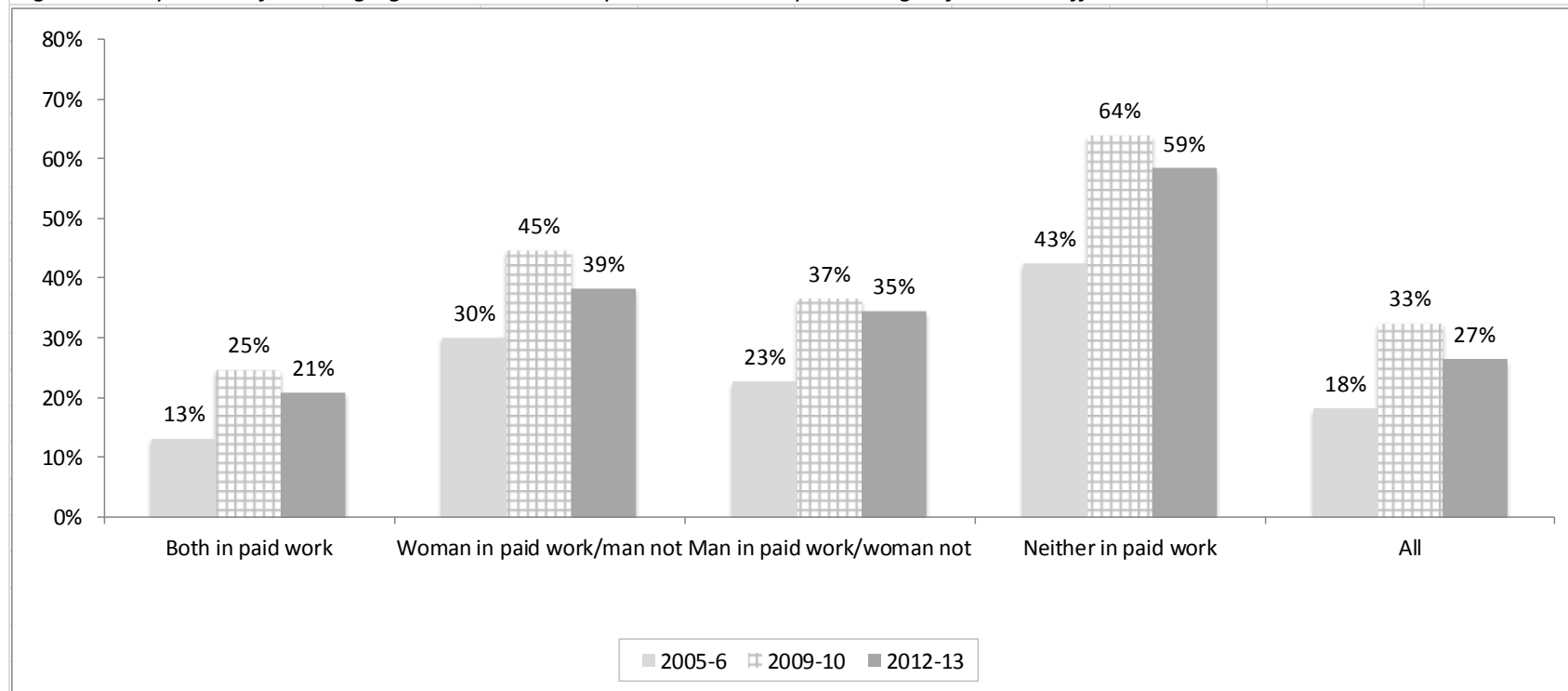
