Referral	
1.1 Process	How referral was initiated, factors that indicated admission was necessary
1.2 Feelings about referral	How they felt about being referred to the unit
1.3 Involvement of YP & family	Decisions about care, input (if any) into unit being referred to.
1.4 Expectations	Thoughts/concerns/expectations about being referred to that specific unit
1.5 Outcome/overall impact of admission	If discharged, how are they doing now?
Experiences/Perceptions of Admission	
2.1 Environment/Treatment	Relationships with staff/other patients, ongoing involvement in treatment decisions
2.2 Visits	Frequency. Any issues or difficulties experienced. Any support required from friends/family?
2.3 Positive impacts/consequences of admission	Views about positive consequences for YP/family e.g. experiences being on the wards, improved health outcomes, break away from issues
2.4 Negative impacts/consequences of admission	Views about negative consequences for YP/family e.g. experience of being an inpatient, contact with family, ease of reintegration into family, school, community
2.5 Discharge	Issues regarding continuity of care and the YP's engagement with CAMHS following discharge home
2.6 Comparison with other admissions	Similarities/differences between current and previous admissions (if any)
Post Admission	
3.1 Health	How are they now, thoughts on treatment, areas for improvement
3.2 Home/School/Relationship circumstances	How are they now, any differences to before admission
Reflection	
5.1 Suggestions for changes to reduce admissions	Areas in need of improvement
5.2 Advice to others in similar position	"If you knew then what you know now"
